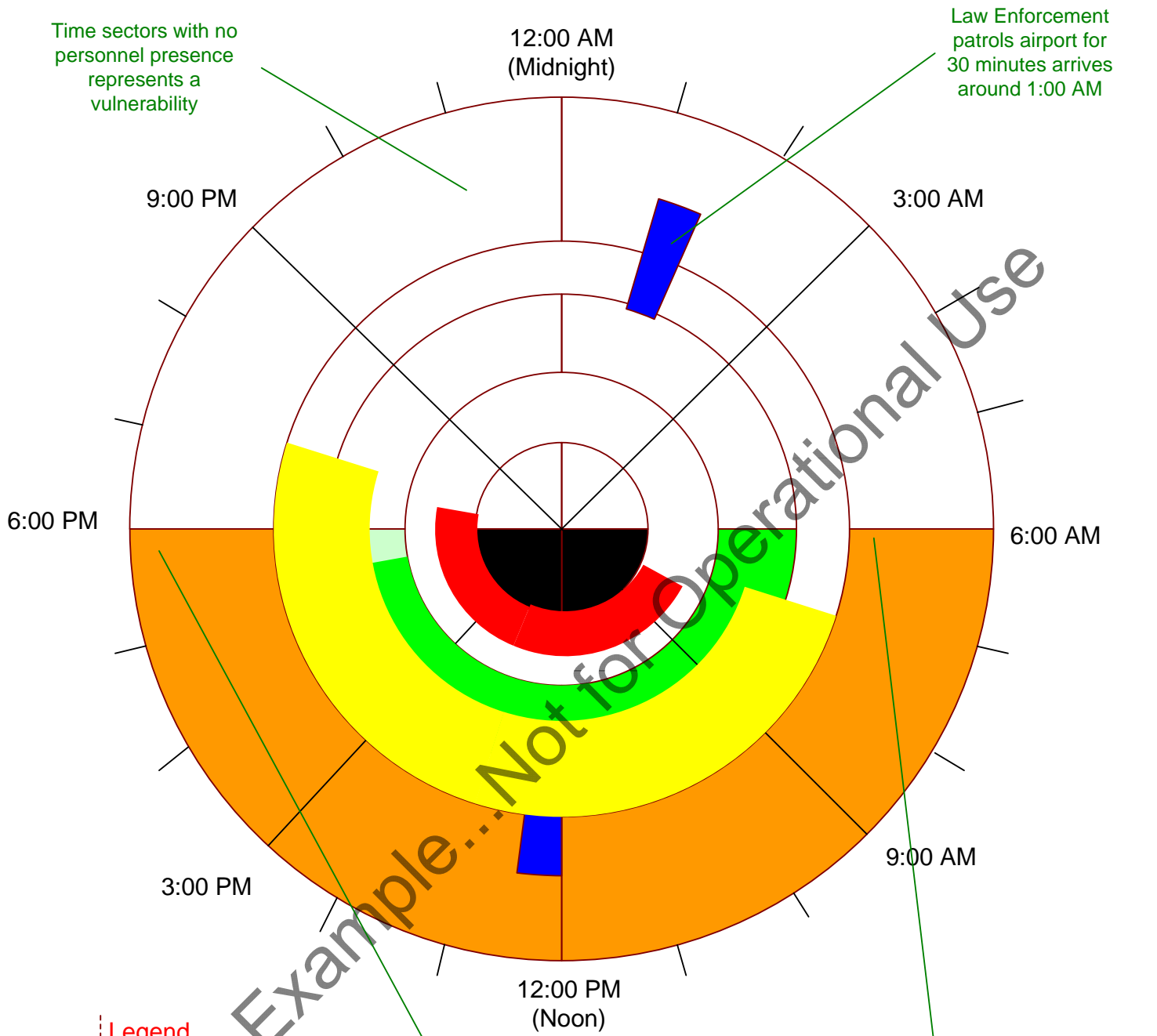

Securing aviation one airport at a time

Instructions for Use

- Step 1: List all of the different types of manned activities at your airport (FBOs, Tenants, Flight Schools, Airport Management, etc)
- Step 2: Identify when the first person of that activity normally arrives at the airport. Then identify when the last person for that activity departs the airport.
- Step 3: Make a filled-in ring sector on the Personnel Presence Vulnerability Chart for that activity (see example). Note: Using different colors for each segment helps to visualize when each particular activity is present at the airport.
- Step 4: Complete a PPVC for each day that has differing start and end times.
- This chart now shows when your airport is especially vulnerable to criminals and terrorists based upon the lack of personnel.
- *Note: This information should be treated as sensitive*

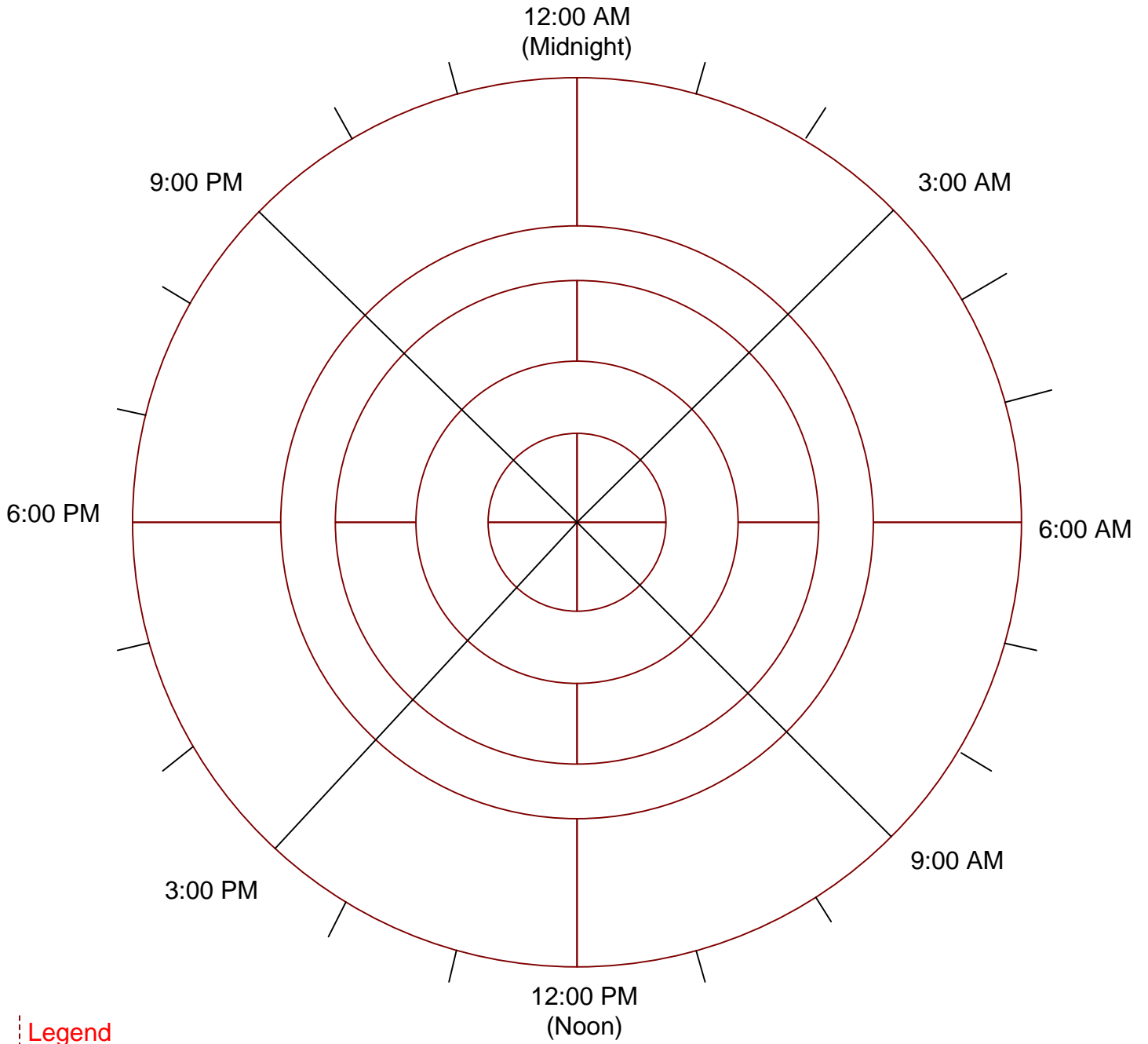
